Re: Release certificates from CMC Electronics

To whom it may concern,

The purpose of this letter is to inform customers on the type of release certificates that Esterline/CMC Electronics can issue to them.

1. For any new product manufactured by CMC a Certificate of Conformity (CoC) could be issued if requested by customers.

In addition when products are certified by Transport Canada (Can-TSO) or part of its Manufacturing certificate then CMC could issue a TCCA Form One. Based on the Agreement between the government of Canada and the government of the United States of America for promotion of aviation safety

(http://www.fc.gc.ca/eng/civilaviation/standards/int-baa-usa-2000-3676.htm) the Contracting Parties agree to accept by each Contracting Party of the other Party's of airworthiness approvals. This means that a Form One issued by a Canadian company is accepted by the FAA and is equivalent to the FAA 8130-3 form.

2. For any product repaired or overhauled by CMC a Certificate of Conformity (CoC) could be issued if requested by customers.

In addition when products appear on its capabilities list (available on CMC's website) CMC could issue the following certificates:

- TCCA Form One/ EASA Part-145 (under the Bilateral Agreement the TCCA Form One is equivalent to the FAA 8130-3 & EASA 145 under the Technical Agreement)
- TCCA Form One/ EASA Part-145 / HKCAD (Hong Kong)
- TCCA Form One/ EASA Part-145 / Canada-Singapore TA-M
- TCCA Form One/ EASA Part-145/ Canada-Brazil ANAC
- CAAC AAC-038 (Chinese)
